- 3.The under 16 Championship Trophy (Gross).**
- 4.The first 16 competitors (gross) qualify for the Boys' Match-play Finals.**

Entries limited to players holding a bona-fide 10 handicap or less on Friday 7th July.

The competition is limited to 48 players.

Competitors will play from their handicaps as at the day of the event. Where handicaps have changed since the date of entry, a current handicap certificate will be required.

In the event of a tie the Pattinson Cup will be held jointly by the tied participants. All other prizes will be decided over the last 18, 9, 6, 3, or 1 holes in that order, thereafter by decision of the Union Committee.

No competitor may take more than one prize.

In the event of too many entries being received, the Committee reserves the right to eliminate, by ballot, the higher handicaps.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and its decision is final.
